Acts Chapter 1

1. v1 Who's acts are recorded in this book? Who is it about? Who are we likely to make the focus of the book if we're not careful?
2. v6-7 What did the apostles get wrong? How are these verses comforting for us?
3. v8 What is the mission of the church? What is the means to carry it out?
4. v9 How is the ascension important for us as the church left on Earth?
5. How would you describe the church in v13-15? How are we in a better position than then in our current church family?
6. What are they doing in v14 that gives you hope? How can we continue to be a church family together like that?
7. What is the difference between an apostle and today's church leadership v21-22? What do we need to learn from them?

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8. Spend some time praying 'with one accord' for God through his Spirit to come and make us effective witnesses to Jesus and his resurrection life.
